Public Services

Digital Identity: 80% citizens using digital ID

Connectivity: Gigabit for everyone, 5G everywhere
Cutting edge Semiconductors: double EU share in global production
Data – Edge & Cloud: 10,000 climate neutral highly secure edge nodes
Computing: first computer with quantum acceleration

Tech up-take: 75% of EU companies using Cloud/AI/Big Data

Late adopters: more than 90% of European SMEs reach at least a basic level of digital intensity

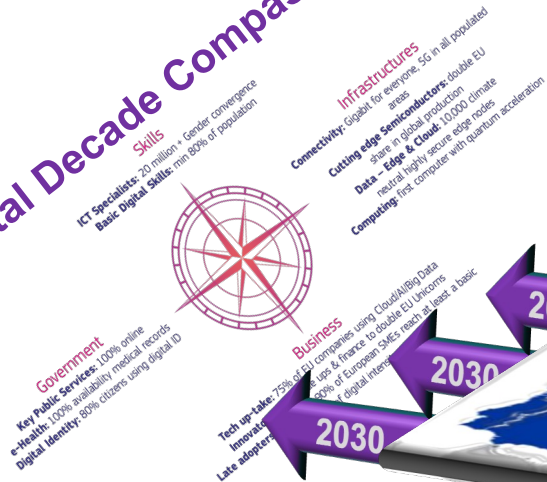

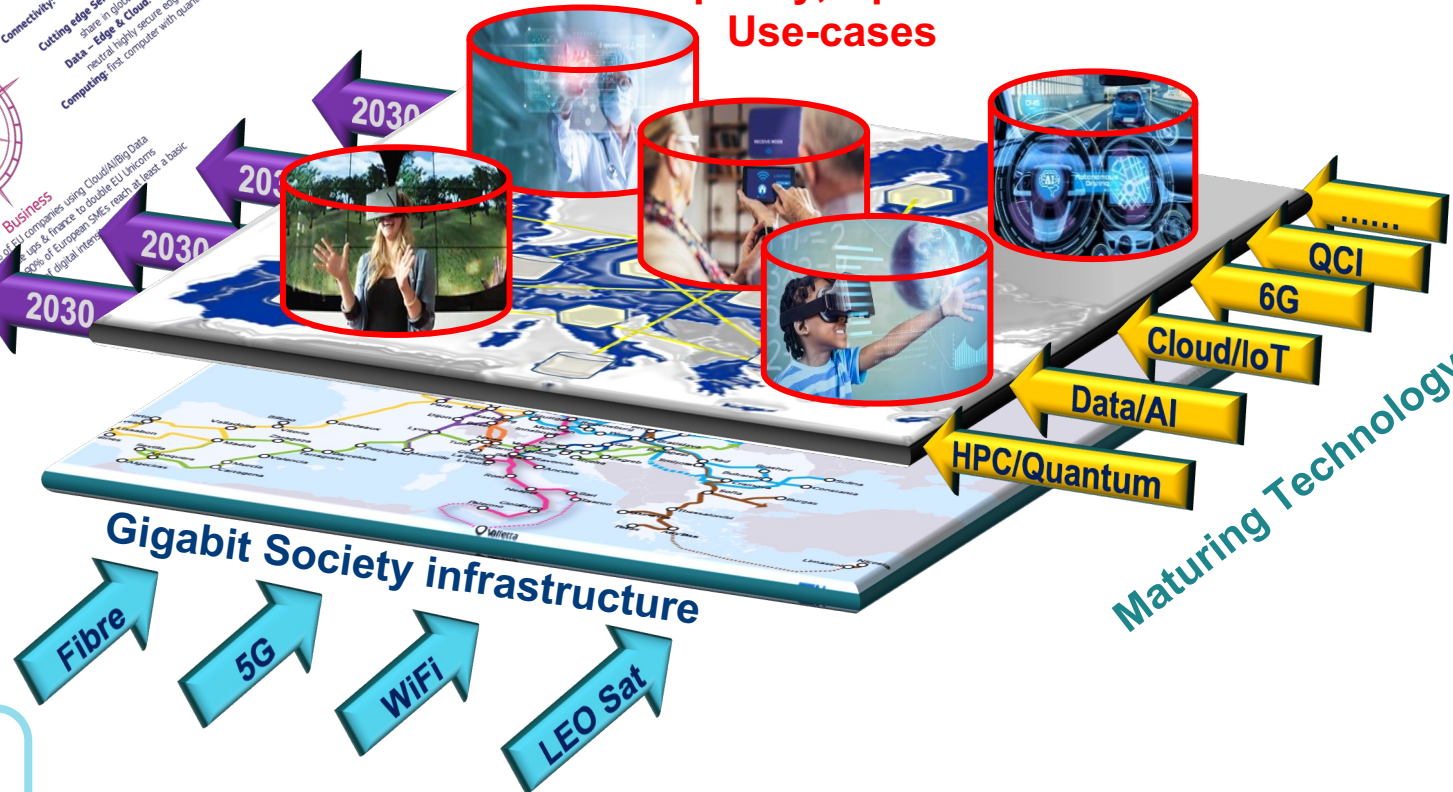

- The Hexa-X flagship + 9 6G exploratory projects = 65 M€



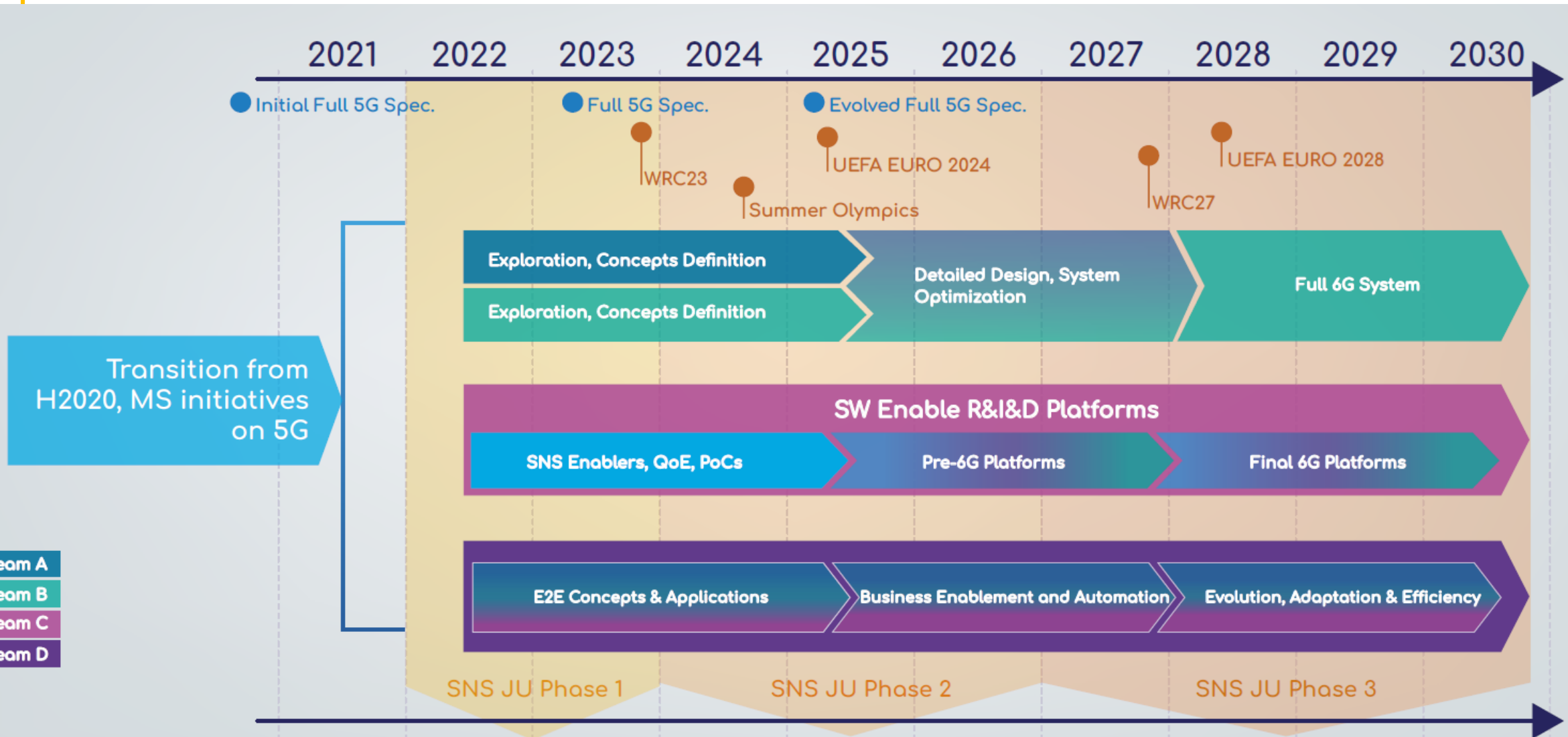

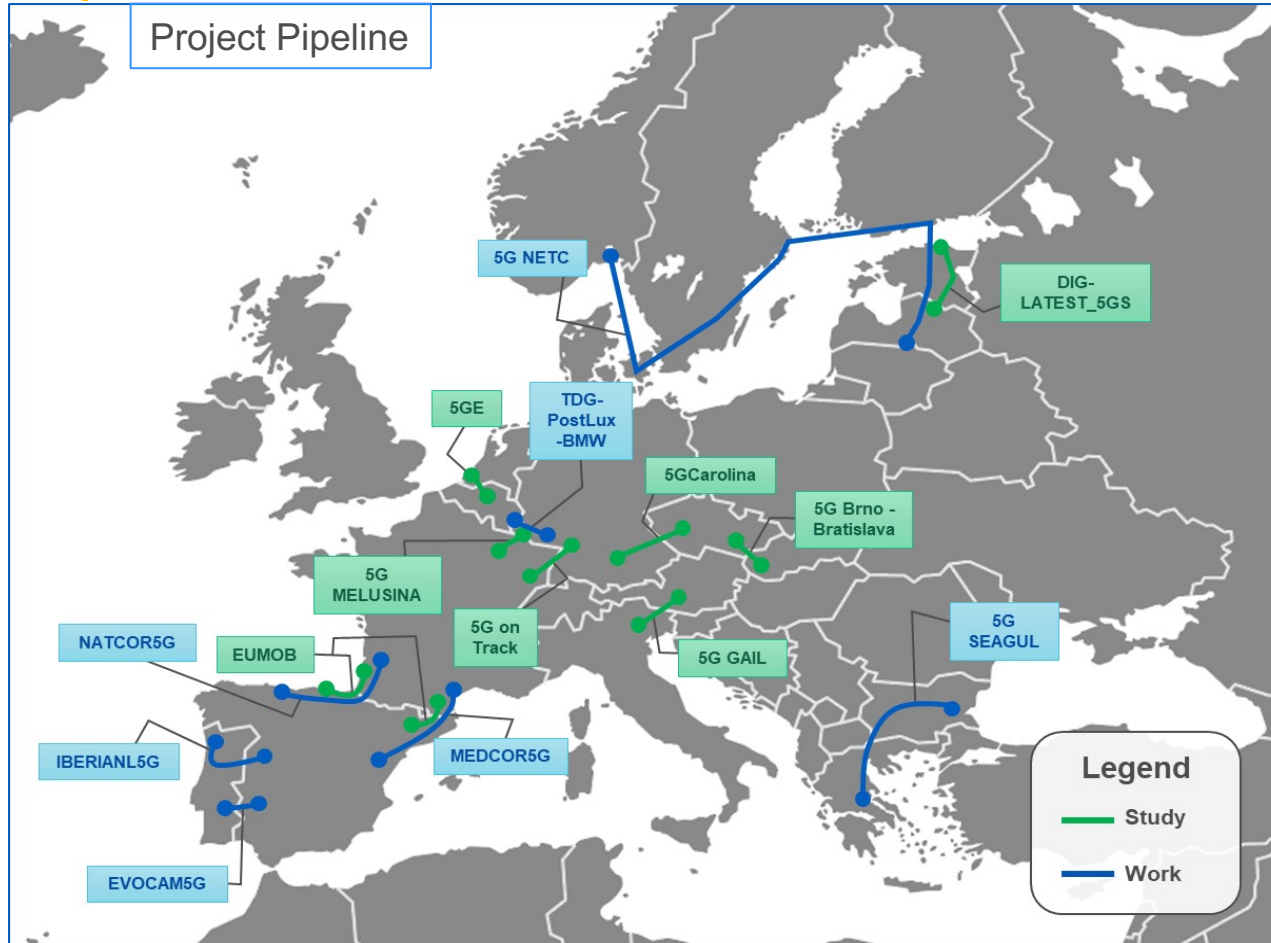
- Tasks set by Council Regulation (2021/2085)
- EU upfront commitment of **€900M** between 2021-2027 (to be at least matched by industry)
- Close involvement of Member States for strategic guidance
- Dedicated Programme Office
- SNS Call 1 (~250 M€): 35 new Projects started on 01/01/2023 with
 - 288 unique beneficiaries
 - ~18% funding for SMEs
 - ~30% not 6G-IA members

SNS 5G Deployment pillar

Multi-Country Project (MCP) – 5G Corridors



- 15 Call 1 cross-border projects selected:
 - 7 Works projects: € 41 million
 - 8 Inception studies: € 2.1 million
- Good mix of road and rail projects, encouraging geographic coverage
- Room and scope to increase coverage during calls 2 (open until 23/02/2023) and Call 3 (2023 ~Q3)

5G Corridors Works	25.000.000	Up to 50%
5G Corridors Studies	3.000000	(cross-border)
5G for Smart Communities	50.000.000	Up to 75%

DIGITAL EUROPE - Securing 5G Strategic Digital Infrastructures and Technologies

- Scope

- Support to 5G cybersecurity, contribute to the 5G cybersecurity “toolbox”.
- Capacity building of security and interoperability aspects of open and disaggregate solutions, such as Open RAN.

- Expected outcome

- Trusted and secure 5G services.
- Cooperation between national authorities and private technology providers on piloting, testing and integration of security and interoperability aspects of 5G solutions.

- Targeted stakeholders: All stakeholders, in particular national authorities (such as regulators of electronic communications or security agencies).

- Projects involving national authorities from several EU Member States will be prioritized.

- Topic details

- Simple Grants (50% funding rate).
- Foreseen project duration: 12-36 Months
- Security restrictions under Article 12(5) apply.
- Foreseen project budget: 1-3 M€

Overall budget: 10 MEUR
